Selected Music & Sound Works

• আকারের খোঁজে (In Search of Form) (2022)

A musical narrative and production based on my Bengali poem, designed with sound, music and recitation. Co-performed with collaborating colleagues who recited and arranged the track.

• The Violence of Words: A Musical Production (2023)

Composed and designed from my original English poem, developed into a musical narrative with collected and recorded sounds, music, singing and recitation. Performed vocals and recitation in collaboration with my Swiss colleague; recorded in Bern, Switzerland. Featured in the video art Kuch To Log Kahenge, The Violence of Words.

• অন্তর ও বাহির (Inner & Outer) (2024)

Wrote, composed and designed this musical narrative from my Bengali poem, blending collected and recorded sounds, music, singing and recitation.

• The Second Reality (2025)

An alternative dark metal rock song in Bengali, written, sung and co-composed for my film The Second Reality (currently in festival review).

• পরাজিত বাহিনী (Defeated Army) (2025)

A collection of five original Bengali heavy metal and alternative rock songs I wrote and co-composed; used in my theatrical piece Porajito Bahini, to be released as an album.

• Who Made Who (2025)

A musical narrative I wrote, designed and co-performed, combining singing and poetry recitations as part of my curatorial project of the same name.

• Upcoming & Ongoing Works

Currently working on my next film (untitled), for which I will compose and design the complete soundscape.

• Dark Metal Rock Single (in progress)

Wrote and composed an original dark metal rock song, collaborating with a vocalist and music arranger, to be released as a single.

Currently in post-production. I will compose and design the entire soundscape, continuing my integration of narrative-driven sound design into moving image work.

• The Second Reality (2024)
